The Commission vide its Order dated: 02.02.2024 cited under reference (1), for self-execution works, the consumer/applicant shall pay to the Licensee, supervision charges at 5% of the estimated cost of the work subject to a maximum of Rs. 15 lakhs, instead of 10% of the estimated cost excluding employees cost and MSD (Meter Security Deposit) subject to a maximum of Rs.15 lakhs as specified in CoS, RoE and other Regulations relating to supply of electricity.

In the matter of: Collection of Supervision Charges for Self-Execution Works-reg.

Preamble:


A Technical Working Group for the revision of the prevailing Common Schedule of Rates across all Govt. Departments of Karnataka was formed vide GO No. PWD 86 RDF 2022 dated 13.02.2023. During the meeting of this group, discussions were held that the existing collection of supervision charges at 10% on the cost of the estimate for self-execution works in the jurisdiction of Distribution Licensees and KPTCL are on higher side and has recommended for collection of supervision charges at 5% on the cost of the estimate. Based on the recommendations, a Government Order has been issued publishing the Common Schedule of Rates 2023-24 applicable to all the Govt. Departments. In this regard, the Commission has received requests from the ESCOMs seeking clarification regarding collection of Supervision Charges at 5% of the cost of the estimate for self-execution works, as per the published Common Schedule of Rates 2023-24.

The Commission notes that, in the Conditions of Supply of Electricity of Distribution Licensees in the State of Karnataka(CoS) and KERC (Recovery of Expenditure for Supply of Electricity), Regulations, 2004 (RoE) and other regulations relating to supply of electricity, it is specified that for self-execution works, the consumer/applicant has to pay supervision charges at 10% of the estimated cost excluding employees cost and MSD (Meter Security Deposit) subject to a maximum of Rs.15 lakhs. In view of this, the Commission has decided to approve collection of 5% supervision charges on the cost of the estimate for self-execution works, duly invoking the provision contained under the clause 46.00 of the CoS, for removal of difficulties. Hence, the following order:

ORDER

The Commission hereby orders that for self-execution works, the consumer/applicant shall pay to the Licensee, supervision charges at 5% of the estimated cost of the work subject to a maximum of Rs. 15 lakhs, instead of 10% of the estimated cost excluding employees cost and MSD (Meter Security Deposit) subject to a maximum of Rs.15 lakhs as specified in CoS, RoE and other Regulations relating to supply of electricity, with immediate effect. Accordingly, the office is directed to propose necessary amendments to relevant clauses of the Regulations, duly following the procedure.

This Order is signed and issued by the Karnataka Electricity Regulatory Commission at Bengaluru, and the order is effective from the date of this order.

In the matter of: Availing multiple connections by LT residential Consumers to their premises.

Preamble:


The Commission has been receiving complaints from the LT residential consumers that the ESCOMs are not sanctioning multiple connections to their premises even though there is requirement for the same. This has caused inconvenience to the consumers, as they have to approach the ESCOM offices frequently, in order to obtain multiple connections to their premises, which is avoidable. In this regard, the Commission, in its Tariff Order 2024 dated 28.02.2024 has introduced a single slab for energy charges, allowing the LT residential consumers to avail multiple connections to their premises as per the requirement.

The Commission is of the view that the LT residential Consumers may avail multiple connections to their premises as per the requirement since the slab for energy charges is solitary. Thus, the Commission, duly invoking the provision contained under the clause 46.00 of the CoS, for removal of difficulties, hereby decides to allow multiple connections to the LT residential consumers as per their request. Hence, the following order:

ORDER

The Commission hereby orders that in view of the introduction of a single slab for energy charges, the Distribution Licensees shall allow the LT residential consumers to avail multiple connections to their premises as per their request. The office is directed to propose necessary amendments to CoS accordingly duly following the procedure.
