Preamble:

WHEREAS, the Commission has issued the Tariff Orders-2025 in respect of BESCOM / MESCOM / CESC / HESCOM / GESCOM and Hukeri Rural Electric Co-operative Society Limited (HRECS) on 27th March 2025.

WHEREAS the Commission's order dated 27.09.2023, which extended the "Green Tariff" to LT consumers, was inadvertently not incorporated into the Tariff Order 2025.

Hence, the following amendment order.

Para 6.15.2 (Page No.254) of of Combined Tariff order 2025 for ESCOMs and Para 4.10.2 (Page No.81) of Tariff order 2025 for HRECS	<u>Tariff for Green Power:</u> In order to encourage generation and use of green power in the State, the Commission decides to continue the existing Green Tariff of 50 paise per unit as the additional tariff over and above the normal tariff to be paid by HT-consumers, who opt for supply of green power from out of the renewable energy procured by distribution utilities over and above their Renewable Purchase Obligation(RPO). The Commission directs ESCOMs to give wide publicity about the availability of RE power through newspapers/ media/ interaction meeting with the industrial consumers.	<u>Tariff for Green Power:</u> In order to encourage generation and use of green power in the State, the Commission decides to continue the existing Green Tariff of 50 paise per unit to HT Consumers and to extend the same to LT-Consumers also on payment of additional tariff of 50 paise per unit by consumers, who opt for supply of green power from out of the renewable energy procured by distribution utilities over and above their Renewable Purchase Obligation(RPO). The Commission directs ESCOMs to give wide publicity about the availability of RE power through newspapers/ media/ interaction meeting with the industrial consumers.
